- 3.2.5 The Council shall be directly responsible for overseeing all activities of the IMM in relation to profits and loss account, complaints or feedback from members and participants of IMM activities, press statements, discipline among members, and the financial status of the IMM.
- 3.2.6 The Council shall be responsible for negotiating and signing all documents with the nominated Contractor awarded the Contract to operate the Secretariat of the IMM which will run all activities of the IMM.
- 3.2.7 The day-to-day management of the affairs of the IMM shall be exercised by the Honorary Secretary of the IMM acting under the authority of the Council.
